This week, have been finding out about astronauts and the work they do to help us learn about the solar system. The children have impressed us with their recall of facts about Mae Jemison, Chris Hadfield and Neil Armstrong. We have learnt that books about the life of a person are called a 'biography' - if you have any at home, please put a photo on Tapestry for us to share.

In maths, we have been counting in 2s to 20, 10s to 100 and 5s to 50. Please keep practising this at home. We have also been representing the different patterns using Numicon, 10 frames and 100 squares.

This week we have also started working in our new phonics groups, with the children taking part in teaching activities that best meet their next step. On a Friday, the activities they bring home will link to their learning and may be different to what their friends are doing. This is to best meet everyone's individual needs, is linked to our regular assessments, and support each children to progress on their own learning journey.
