This Week

This week, we have shared the story *Whatever Next?* by Jill Murphy. The children have been thinking about what they would take on a trip to the moon and sharing their knowledge of the things they might see on the way. We have been very impressed by their knowledge of the Solar System! The children also thought that a cardboard box might not be the best vehicle for space travel so we have spent time finding out about rockets, then designing and making our own.

In phonics this week, we have been using the trigraphs **igh**, **ear**, **air** and **ure** in reading and writing activities.

In maths, we have been counting in twos to 10 and then 20. We have also been finding out about odd and even numbers, using Numicon and 10 frames to see which amounts can be built with twos and which have an odd block
