We have had a very busy week, finding out about Shrove Tuesday celebrations around the world, taking part in World Book Day, and continuing our learning about our Solar System. In maths, we have been sharing amounts into equal groups. The children are becoming very good at seeing when the groups are the same or 'fair'. We have been practicing describing the groups as 'x lots of y', e.g. 6 can be shared into 3 lots of 2.
