This week we have been thinking about belonging at Ely St. John's and talking about the different people who keep us safe at school. The children have created their own 'safety circles', drawing pictures of adults who look after them at home and school. We have also been finding out about pandas, so that we can help the class pandas to make their own All About Me books!

In phonics this week, we have introduced:

i as in insect n as in nut

m as in meatball d as in drum

The children have also been taught how to use sound buttons to read 2 and 3 letter words. Ask them to show you!

In maths we have been finding out about the number one, using the Numberblocks to help us to explore one, once, only, and more than one. We have also been creating art with circles and lines, looking at the work of Kandinsky and Gene Davis for inspiration.
