Headteacher's Notes:

As we break for the February half term holiday today, it is an opportunity to pause and look back at the first half of our academic year Together. There have been so many highlights already which makes it almost impossible to pick out ones to mention here, suffice to say that our EJ Way statement, 'We are excited to learn new things' is in evidence every single day across the school. Well done Team ESJ!

We are actually somewhat over the exact halfway point in the school year in terms of the number of school days due to the varying term lengths - 103 days completed, 87 remaining. With my responsibility to monitor pupil attendance, I wanted to highlight to you all both the importance of good attendance and the impact on lost learning that poor attendance can have. There are times when we are all not well, and being absent from school to rest and recover is the best option, and we obviously do recognise and support that. For your information though, national guidelines for pupil attendance and the impact of late arrivals across a school year are shown below...
